

Tips for Taking a Survey of Your Women

Knowing the strengths and weaknesses of your women's ministry can help to direct your prayers and plans. Taking a survey is one way to find out how the women you are serving perceive the effectiveness of the ministry.

The best volume of responses comes when you send a note in the email with the survey saying this will only take 60 seconds of your time. Keep the survey to 5, or no more than 10, questions and leave options for comments on every question so that they can voice thoughts that the survey doesn't cover.

Survey Monkey provides the use of a scale from 1- 5, or other options, to make it simple for the women to respond.

You can offer to share the results, via an email link, with those who respond, if they leave an email address with the survey. Survey Monkey has options for sharing the results with others, either including comments or leaving them out.

Possible Questions

Answer on a scale of 1-5 with 5 being the strongest:

- I am provided with many opportunities and ways to connect to other women in the church
- I feel connected to other women in the church
- I have an opportunity to study the Word with other women
- I have access to service opportunities within the church
- I have a clear understanding of my creation design as a woman
- I feel welcome to communicate my ideas/thoughts about women's ministries in our church and I have clear pathways to do so and know who to contact
- I receive regular communication that I am prayed for by other women in our church
- If I have a personal crisis I know how to get help from my church
- I am engaged in daily prayer and spending time in God's Word
- I desire to be disciplined by an older woman
- I desire to disciple a younger woman
