

How does **cdm** serve the PCA?

PCA Discipleship Ministries (CDM) is a committee of the PCA General Assembly whose mission is to help local churches “make disciples” through ministry to children, youth, and adults. We do this through connection—connecting people to people and people to resources.

Here are a few ways PCA members can benefit from the ministry of CDM.

Any Church Member

The **PCA Bookstore** (pcabookstore.com or call 800-283-1357) offers books and studies that are vetted by PCA leaders at prices that are competitive with other sellers (including Amazon). - a “one-stop shop” for resources on ministry to women: videos, Bible study recommendations, *enCourage* blog posts and podcasts, training resources, etc.
- *Connect PCA Women's Ministry Facebook Group* is an open group for those serving in women's ministry. Participants share ideas for resources and provide encouragement.
