Under the enthusiastic leadership of CDM Trainer Connie Miller, CDM Women's Ministry International (WMI) has shared CDM training curriculum in 7 countries (with 3 more on the horizon) and is working with the following ministry partners:

MTW, UK Partnership, South African Reformed Mission, Redeemer City to City—Latin America, Presbyterian Church of Ireland (PCI), and the International Presbyterian Church (IPC). Pastors and women's leaders around the world are embracing the Word-based, relationally-driven model for women's discipleship that CDM has offered for years. In September, the WMI Team gathered by Zoom to discuss how to steward well the opportunities God has given.

Wives of Elders (WE)

The response to the Wives of Elders (WE) ministry continues to reveal the great need to connect this vital group of ministry leaders. Since March, the contact list has grown over 500% to almost 2000 women. CDM WE Ministry liaison Meaghan May is developing a team, along with a strategy, to serve these women well. Over the past year, the group has participated in online and in-person gatherings, seminars, a Bible study, and a *Partners in the Gospel* book club.

The Song of Advent by Caleb Click combines Scripture, a homily, and a hymn to proclaim Christ as the ultimate Song of the season.


