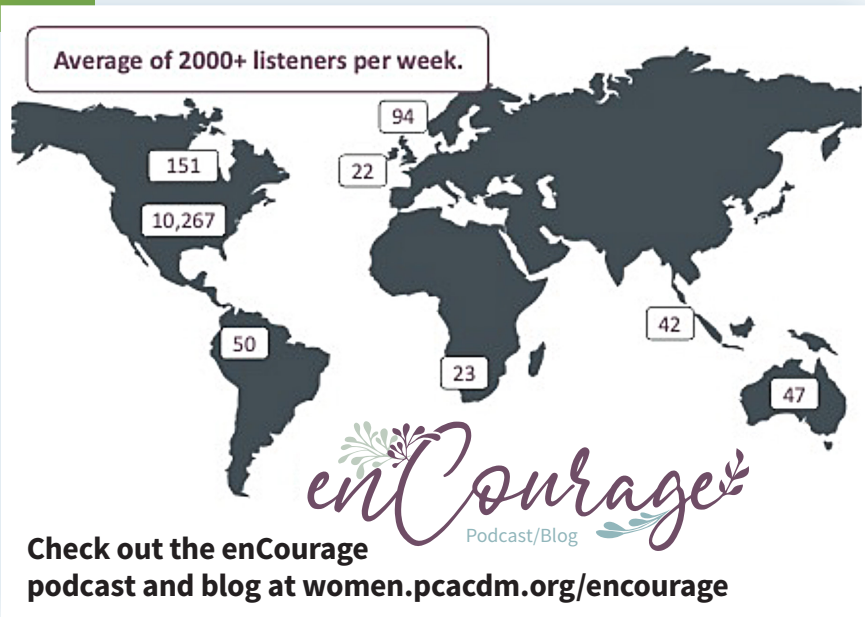

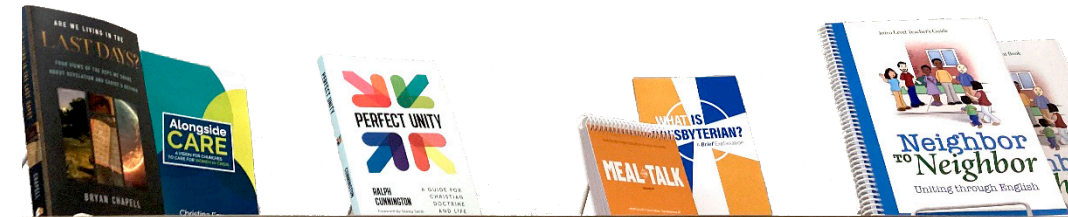


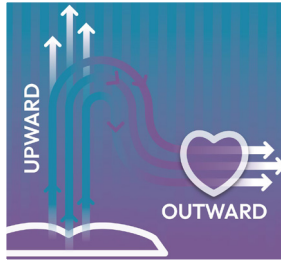
Making Disciples

A Covenantal Framework for Life and Ministry

Each February, CDM hosts Women’s Ministry leaders from around the PCA (and even the world) for a time of encouragement and training we call “LT.” In 2024, we had our largest group ever as over 500 gathered in Atlanta to consider how covenant theology shapes ministry to women.

The response from attendees was very encouraging:

During LT, CDM also celebrated 50 years of PCA Women’s Ministry by honoring those who have served since the early years of the denomination. With 20% of LT attendees this year under the age of 40, honoring these “Legacy Women” was a great testimony to God’s faithfulness to raise up biblically-faithful leaders from generation to generation.

Certification Update

At the CDM LEAD Retreat, another Children’s Ministry Certification class graduated! After 5 years, over 170 leaders have completed the program. A new class began in January with 36 students, including a PCA leader in Norway!

In late 2023, CDM launched the Teach Us to Worship (TUTW) program as part of our service to congregations and children’s ministry leaders.



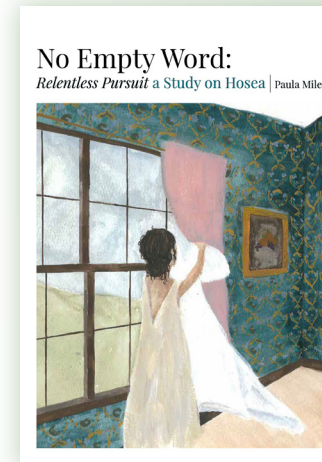
The TUTW Mission: Provide training and resources to equip the local church and cultivate an atmosphere where covenant children flourish as lifelong worshippers.

The Women’s Ministry Summer Study



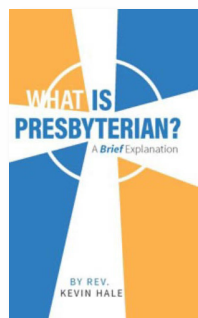
No Empty Word:
