

# WHY GOD GAVE US A BOOK

**TO THE READER:** A good learning technique is to answer the following questions BEFORE reading the booklet. After reading, you can refine your answers based on your reading. Then, when your group gathers, each can discuss his or her view and you can either affirm or modify what you wrote.

1. Does God still speak to us today? If so, how does He do it? (5-10)
2. What was the #1 reason God gave us the Bible? (10-13)
3. In what sense do we meet God in the Bible? (13-16)
4. What do we mean when we talk about “God’s Law,” or the “Law of God?” (16-20)
5. Read Habakkuk 1:13a, Matthew 5:48, and Romans 6:23. What hope can there be for us? (20-22)
6. How important is the Bible? Why? How important is it to you? Why? (22-24)
